Monitor new development and directions of US government policies and public opinion on execution and promotion of domestic and international education programs. Monitor notable developments in STEM education and science & technology talent development initiatives in k-12 schools, higher education institutions, and the private sector in the US and overseas. Prepare periodic reports and promotional materials to include brief introduction of American education systems, educational trends and career development programs and initiatives. Analyze the effects of development and implementation of international educational and cultural exchange programs on improving US global competitiveness and the world economic development particularly in the Asian and Pacific regions. Foster exchange between educators, educational administrators, and education policy makers in the US, Japan and the Asia Pacific region to help improve educational outcomes in these regions. Conduct a wide range of social science related research projects which include preparing and managing extensive databases and preparing project-related reports, manuscripts and presentations.
